## **Board of Directors Special Emergency Meeting**

Call to Order: 3:30pm

**Roll Call:** Mike Burt, Tina Fritz and Paul Rimola by speakerphone.

Burt declared "We have a quorum, we can proceed".

**Appointment of New Directors**: Tina Fritz stated that it would be appropriate to just fill one position (Dustin Joll's #3) at this meeting; waiting until next meeting to fill Al Anton's position as Position #5. This would give others an opportunity to apply once it's posted. It was agreed upon by the other Directors to only appoint Karl Kowalski to Dustin Joll's position #3 tonight.
