When you adopt a fire hydrant you are agreeing to take care of that hydrant. That means you need to make sure it is cleared of anything growing near it, such as weeds. Make sure the blowing sand is cleared away from it. It must be accessible and clearly seen from the road. It can never be blocked by parked cars or anything else.

Now comes the fun part. You can paint the fire hydrant anyway you want to. You can make it look like a character, or an object, or just colors. You cannot attach anything to it, like beads, or chains, or scarves, or hats, etc. You are not allowed to portray anything that could be controversial, political, religious, sexual, defamatory, or demeaning.

Every year, in June, the Fire Fighters will go around the District, and judge all the decorated hydrants, and the winner will get a prize.
